The United States Postal Service portrays the American experience to a world audience through its postage stamps. Almost all subjects chosen to appear on US stamps are suggested by the public. The Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee was formed for the purpose of evaluating these proposals in 1957.

The primary goal of the Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee is to select subjects that are both interesting and educational for recommendation to the Postmaster General, who then decides which stamps will be issued. Besides recommending 25 to 40 new subjects for commemorative stamps each year, the Committee also recommends subjects for the extensive line of regular stamps. The Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee thinks of stamp collectors as well as all citizens and looks for stamp designs that will be consistent with public sentiment, and have broad national appeal.
